News from 22 Engr Regt in Afghanistan



On 24th March, a sunny day in Lashkar Gah in Central Helmand, the Commanding Officers of 21 Engineer Regiment and 22 Engineer Regiment shook hands to signify the official transfer of authority between their units for continued operations in Afghanistan this year.

"It is proud moment for 22 Engineer Regiment to follow on from such a prestigious unit as 21 Engineer Regiment," said Commanding Officer 22 Engineer Regiment, Lieutenant Colonel Jason Kerr. "We look forward to the challenges ahead this summer, safe in the knowledge that we could not have had a better handover."

It didn't take long after the official handover for the soldiers of 22 Regiment Royal Engineers to get on with the task. Here they are building new sangar defences at FOB Shawqat in Helmand Province. Working above the fence-line, they have to wear their full Personal Protective Equipment, even in the scorching midday sun.

Operational Honours and Awards

The list of Operational Honours and Awards for Op HERRICK 16 was announced on Friday 22nd March, with several Servicemen from this Garrison receiving awards and decorations for actions during the period April - September 2012 when they were deployed as part of 12 (Mechanized) Brigade.

Pte Lewis Treloar was awarded an MBE for his work as a lead IED Searcher with 1st Battalion The Royal Anglian Regiment. His instinct for finding where insurgents had hidden their deadly devices led to the discovery of at least 40 major stores during his tour of Afghanistan. This denial of lethal aid to the

insurgents came at an important time and left the insurgents unable to re-establish themselves. Lewis also had an ability to build friendships with the local Afghan community, using the Pashto language skills he had learned before deploying, to the extent that he became

somewhat of a celebrity with the local Afghans who sought him out to tell him what they knew about the insurgents in the area.

Good News for local Enterprise

£2.63m funding has been released for Phase 2 of the Castledown Business Park, near Ludgershall. Work to fence and prepare the ground works will start after Easter, with construction beginning in early May. The developers, St Modwen, plan to have the new buildings completed by the end of this year.

The phase 2 build will be next door to the current Fitz Gilbert Court development, with 15 new units varying in size from 710 to 6,100 sq ft. Early interest is already being shown in this new planned development, from present tenants needing more space to companies moving into the area.

There is also keen interest in the recently opened Incubation Centre which offers flexible office and desk space to start-up businesses or those needing more space to grow within a stimulating business environment. With free specialist business advice and guidance, WiFi access and fast broadband connectivity, access to Rural Enterprise Grants and many other advantages available to tenants, this facility will be of great interest to anyone considering starting or growing a small business in Wiltshire. Service leavers and spouses will be made particularly welcome.

"This is important news for the community and for military personnel and their families too", said Garrison Commander, Colonel Paddy Tabor.

Army 2020 - How it affects us here on Salisbury Plain

The Ministry of Defence revealed the details of its plans for the restructuring and re-basing of the Army on 5th March. The Unit moves will take place over the next few years and will be fully complete by 2020.

These moves include the repatriation of British Units from Germany, where they have been based since the end of the Second World War.

The Salisbury Plain Garrisons are set to welcome around 4,000 extra troops and their families over the next few years and £850 million is being made available to provide the necessary working and living accommodation, plus the extra medical, dental, schooling and leisure facilities which that number of extra people will require.

Shortly after the Secretary of State's announcement in the House of Commons, a briefing was held in Tidworth when Colonel Paddy Tabor, Acting Commander 43 (Wessex) Brigade, and Jane Scott, Leader of Wiltshire Council, explained the basing plans and the effect they will have on the Salisbury Plain area.

All three Armoured Infantry Brigades in the Army's future "Reaction Force" will be located in Wiltshire, together with their Armoured vehicles and supporting units. 1 Brigade and 12 Brigade are already located in TNB Garrison; the third, 20 Brigade, will move to Bulford from Sennelager in 2017. In addition, several Gunner units will



be arriving in Larkhill, the spiritual home of the Royal Artillery. Other units moves are listed below.

Between now and 2017, a lot of work will be done to build single living accommodation, technical accommodation (hangars, garaging and workshops) and around 1,200 married quarters for the incoming troops and their families.

"This provides a once in a lifetime opportunity to look at what we need, to build the housing we actually require for the future here in the local area so people don't have miles to drive to work and they can send their children to the local schools, here in Tidworth or in Bulford ... that is the plan underpinning these really major moves", said Colonel Tabor.

For the past 8 years, Wiltshire Council has been operating a 'Military/Civilian Integration' programme, to ensure that local services respond to the changing requirements of the Armed Forces.

The Council will be working with the Army, the DIO and other public services, to ensure that there is sufficient housing, (both military and civilian), as well as sufficient school places (both primary and secondary), and medical, dental and leisure facilities for the large number of people who will be arriving to live on this end of the Plain.

"We'll work with the military very closely - as we always do", said Jane Scott. "They will have good facilities, good local facilities and they will enjoy working and living in Wiltshire".

"The other important issue for us is the economy. The MOD is the largest employer in the County and it is

important that we work closely with them, not only to make sure that dependants have suitable jobs in the area but also so that we make sure that the requirements of the Army are met with proper skills that they require.

"There are always going to be personnel coming out of the Army and we are working very closely to ensure that the skills of those people coming out match the skills that are required in the (civilian) workforce, particularly as Wiltshire is the second favourite place for Army personnel to retire to, or to spend the rest of their working life in. We are also building more 'incubation units' for personnel



leaving the Army to set up their own businesses.

"We're very pleased with this news" Jane Scott concluded. "It is wonderful for our communities and we welcome it a great deal".

New Science College given the go-ahead

The Department for Education has approved an application to set up the country's first Defence Industries University Technical College (UTC) in Salisbury. 43 (Wx) Brigade has been a partner in the bid.

UTCs are brand new state schools for 14-18 year-olds, specialising in Science and Engineering and open to all. Students will gain industry-recognised Engineering and Science qualifications alongside more traditional academic qualifications like GCSEs and A Levels.

The distinctive characteristic of UTCs is their close links with employers and universities. The South Wiltshire UTC is sponsored by the University of Southampton and will harness its expertise and specialist lecturers to introduce students to cutting-edge technology. Major local employers from the Defence and Protective Science industries will provide guest lecturers and work placements, to ensure that students have the skills and attitudes that employers value. The Army will provide support in areas like leadership and team-building.

The UTC will be worth more than £40m to the area over the next ten years and is expected to be a highly attractive option for children from Forces families. In particular, it is planned that military children (under the Service Premium arrangements) will have priority within the school's admissions rules. The UTC will open in Sep 2014 for 14-16s, and fully open for 14-18s twelve months later.
