Afghan Governor thanks British Forces

The outgoing Governor of Helmand Province, Mohammad Gulab Mangal, has thanked the ISAF forces for their service and sacrifices in Afghanistan during his four years in office.

The British Commander of Task Force Helmand, Brigadier Doug Chalmers, joined Governor Mangal at his compound in central Lashkar Gah in his final week in post. The pair exchanged gifts, before walking into the provincial capital to enjoy lunch in a newly-opened kebab restaurant and to visit a local market.

Addressing the Brigadier in front of a group of senior provincial representatives, Mangal said:

"Allow me to use this opportunity to thank you on behalf of the entire people of Afghanistan, and particularly the people in Helmand, for all the sacrifices you have made to bring change to this province.

"And I have to talk about the sacrifices that our own security forces have made. They are the deserved sons of this country and they lost their lives to give us a better life. We did it together with British, American, Danish and Estonian forces to bring the change and see a green and colourful Helmand".

Brigadier Chalmers responded:

"I want to thank you for all you've done over the past four years and to mark the engagement the British Forces have had with you over that time.

"I met you for the first time four years ago down in Garmsir when the fighting was very fierce and I was here in 2009 when the rockets were falling just outside your compound. ... I am really honoured and I am very thankful to be able to go into your city and have lunch today because it marks the change we have seen here in the past four years. Everywhere I go I see the market towns and cities of Lashkar Gah and Gereshk, and market towns such as Nad 'Ali which are bustling with trade and protected by Afghan Security Forces."

Governor Mangal concluded: "I hope the next chapter will start from here and I look forward to a future when hopefully we won't be able to hear a single bullet and this will be a peaceful country."

Vikings' Weapons find

Members of B (Suffolk) Company from 1st Battalion the Royal Anglian Regiment (The Vikings) pose for a photograph alongside their Afghan partners, following a significant arms and ammunition find during an Afghan-led Company level Operation into the northern desert region of Nad-e Ali in southern Helmand province. Five separate caches of weapons were found, including rifles, rocket-propelled grenades, IED equipment, grenades and ammunition of all sizes.



With Afghan forces and the Vikings working alongside each other on a daily basis, this, the second large find in the area within the space of two weeks, has served to strengthen their excellent relationship.

"B (Suffolk) Company men are in their fifth month of Op Herrick 16 and ... as absolutely focussed on the mission as they were on day one of the deployment - every one of them doing their bit", commented Maj Adam Wolfe, their Company Commander. "The results of the mission were brilliant, denying the enemy a great deal of weapons and equipment that is currently being used to attack us and the Afghans we work with".

MPGS to the Rescue

On 3rd September, a very distressed Mr James Spencer from Choulston Farm, Netheravon, arrived at speed in his car at the Netheravon Station Guardroom with his father, Mr Cyril Spencer, slumped in the passenger seat, extremely unwell. L/Cpl Forbes and Pte "Spike" Milligan, (above), of the Military Provost Guard Service rushed to assist.



Pte Milligan ascertained that, although breathing steadily, Cyril seemed to be at the point of passing out and so he kept him awake by constantly reassuring him.

Meanwhile, James contacted the Emergency Services on his mobile phone. Pte Milligan gave them what details he could and followed their instructions until the paramedics arrived. The senior paramedic quickly decided that the Wiltshire Air Ambulance would be needed.

L/Cpl Forbes co-ordinated the arrival of the Air Ambulance via the Station Air Traffic Control Tower to land in the field adjacent to the Guardroom and Cyril was flown to Southampton Hospital where he was treated for severe food poisoning.

Cyril visited the Guardroom several days later to present chocolates to the guardroom staff to thank them for their assistance.

Colonel Paddy Tabor, the Garrison Commander said "It is reassuring to know that the local community has such confidence in the professionalism of the Armed Forces".

AWS Poppy Break
