Tidworth Community Awards 2012

The annual Community Awards ceremony took place on 25th April at The Wellington Academy. Certificates were presented by Cllr Brigadier Robert Hall, Chairman of Wiltshire Council, to everyone who received a nomination. The winners in each category were as follows:

The Wiltshire Constabulary (Paul Oatway) Shield for the most valuable contribution to activities for young people was awarded to ex-Royal Engineer, Mr Bob Jones, for his work with 2nd (St Leonards) Scouts in Bulford. It was presented to him by former Tidworth Police Sgt, Paul Oatway.

The Aster Star, recognising selfless and valuable support given to a neighbour or to the elderly, was awarded to Anna Thatcher, David Thatcher and Mike Furnival, Netheravon's Phoenix Hall Management Committee. The Star was presented to them by Julian Paine, Aster Regional Director for Wiltshire.

The Garrison Commander's Award recognises contributions to the Garrison's involvement locally, from which closer ties between our military and civilian communities have directly resulted.

Head Teacher of Kiwi Primary School in Bulford, Susan Raeburn, received more than one nomination for this award. It was presented to her by GCOS, Major Lucy Close, as Garrison Commander, Colonel Paddy Tabor, was unable to be present.

The Tidworth & District Chamber of Commerce Cup is awarded to the business that has contributed the most to its local community. RGV Engineering (Netheravon) Ltd received the award from David Wildman, Chairman of the TDCC.

The Tesco Shield is awarded to the person who has shown the most imagination, determination and commitment in achieving charitable or fundraising targets. Gill Murphy, who has raised some £2500 each year for the last decade, was presented with this award by Brig Robert Hall.

The Schools Challenge Shield goes to an individual or group whose contribution has benefited pupils or a school. Anthea Turner, Head Teacher of Clarendon Infant School in Tidworth was presented with this award by Alex Bostock.

The Aspire Defence Award for the environment was presented to Jamie-Rose Arnold, a pupil at Zouch Primary School, whose letter to Tidworth Town Council focussed attention on the need to clear up dog mess from around the School. She was presented with the award by Stuart McLean of Aspire Defence.

The Community Challenge Shield, the Community's top award for the year, is selected from the winners of the 7 categories above by the Chairman of the Tidworth Area Board and the CAA Organising Committee. Gill Murphy was presented with the award by Mr Chris Williams, Chairman of the Tidworth Area Board.

Congratulations to everyone, including the many military personnel who were nominated for their community efforts, including Jo Rhodes (APHCS), Sgt Adrian 'Chalky' Wiltshire (6 Bn REME), Cpl Franklin (1 R ANGLIAN), Capt Taff Evans (19 Regt RA), Sgt Julian Clark (RMP), Cyclops Sqn 2RTR, Sjt Waqavonovono (4 RIFLES), Bdr Adam Busby (RA), the Army Wives from Cheeky Monkeys Playgroup and Capt Karl Topliss (4Bn REME).

Musical entertainment was provided during the evening by the choirs from local primary schools, Hazel Chalk-Pope from The Wellington Academy and from the Salisbury Plain Military Wives' Choir.

Lock it or Lose it ! Beat Cycle Theft - Always lock your Bike !



Follow this advice from RMP to reduce the chances of your bike being stolen :

- Buy a good quality D-Lock to secure your bike and always lock it to something fixed, like security rails or ground anchors.
- You could even use two locks for extra security - make thieves think it's not worth trying to steal your bike !
- Always lock both wheels and keep the lock off the ground. This makes it harder to break.
- Have your bike frame security marked or tagged.
