Combined Cadet Force is launched at Wellington Academy

There has been no shortage of pupils wanting to join the Wellington Academy's latest facility, a Combined Cadet Force, (CCF), which was officially opened by HM Lord Lieutenant for Wiltshire, Mr John Bush, on 2nd February.

The £1 million facility includes offices, a 25 metre shooting range and a parade ground and will have support from the two units in nearby Perham Down, 22 Engineer Regiment and 26 Engineer Regiment.

"Membership of the Cadet Force will help give (students at the Academy) pride in their appearance and in leadership and with the adult support of the Army they will gain experiences that they will not get anywhere else", said Mr Bush.

The CCF is an integral part of the Academy and with more than 70% of students at the Academy coming from military families, it further cements ties with the Garrison and already has a waiting list.

"Since we started the Cadet Force in September we have been overwhelmed by the response and have had to restrict membership to years 10 and 11", said the Principal of the Academy, Andy Schofield.

"We're finding Students are bringing the skills they learn in the Cadet Force back into the classroom", said Graham Rankin, Head of Year 10 and Commander of the CCF. "It is having a big effect on their behaviour in class and therefore their learning and achievements".

How to watch BFBS TV on ops

You'll get 10 channels of BFBS TV on ops in Afghanistan. As well as the best of British TV on BFBS1 and BFBS2, there's a movie channel, two Sky Sports channels, Sky News, a music channel, a channel specially-timed for Afghanistan and an extra channel in Nepali available to Gurkha soldiers.

Don't forget your laptop !

In many places in Theatre, BFBS TV is broadcast via DTT, just like Freeview in the UK. So as well as on communal televisions, you can also watch live TV in your own bedspace on your laptop, with a digital TV dongle. There's detailed information on the kit you need at www.bfbs.com/digitaltv - you can order and pay for any equipment online and pick it up from BFBS in Bastion on arrival.

BFBS Technology team has come up with the BFBS iPlay system. Where Freeview

is not available, you can download programmes to your laptop or even your PSP and take them with you to watch when you want, whenever you get the chance. You can even share with friends if you've got a memory stick and the beauty of it is that it doesn't need an internet connection. BFBS sends around eight new TV programmes to the iPlay system each day, along with newspapers and magazines.

British Forces News

This is transmitted live every weeknight at 17.30 UK time on BFBS1, and online afterwards at www.bfbs.com/news. It covers issues of warfare, defence policy and military strategy, with live reports from Afghanistan from our two journalists permanently based at Camp Bastion.
