Garrison Commander's Summer Message

With summer nearly upon us and hopefully better weather I thought it appropriate to provide an update to you on Garrison matters.

Firstly, the Army Rebasing Programme is on schedule and the Salisbury Plain Masterplan was published on 20 May. The programme now enters the comment stage prior to moving towards the planning application stage.

What does all this mean? Hopefully if all goes to plan we should see building works related to Army re-basing beginning in mid to late 2015. The next 4 to 5 years will see some upheaval to those who live and work inside the wire and the building of new housing in the surrounding areas but at the end of the Programme the Garrison will be the showpiece Garrison within the UK. For those who are interested I encourage you to read the Masterplan which can be found at www.army.mod.mod/basing.

Secondly, OP REFLECT or the Great War commemorations. There will be numerous events held across the country and within Wiltshire. Within the Garrison I would highlight 2 events.

- **Great War Military History Presentations** in the Tidworth Garrison Theatre on Wednesday, 9 July. There will be a series of free talks throughout the day by published military historians and everyone who is interested is invited to attend. Further details inside ...

- **The Musical Pageant** which will be held on Saturday 27 September beginning at 1630 hrs on the Tattoo Ground, Tidworth. This will be the largest military musical display in the UK this year and will also include performances from the Military Wives Choir. It will culminate in a fireworks display followed by a pop concert performed by one of the military Contemporary Bands. This will party in the park type event and is free.

Thirdly, I would like to flag up the opportunities for sport and other activities. I would encourage individuals to take the opportunity to try their hand at different activities. Within close proximity to the Garrison there is the excellent Tidworth Garrison Golf Club, the Army Parachuting Association at Netheravon and the newly reformed Kiwi Sub Aqua Club based in Bulford. You will not be surprised to discover that there is a charge for these activities but in comparison to civilian clubs there is considerable military discount. So if you are bored or looking for a new challenge then get up and try something new.

Fourthly, and on a serious and worrying note, Wiltshire Constabulary Police have briefed me that they are seeing an increasing number of drink driving convictions amongst the military population. You all know the penalties for a drink driving conviction. Please think before you decide to drink and drive. Is the loss of your license and the other ramifications really worth it?

Minister visits Salisbury Plain

The Minister for the Armed Forces, Mark François, visited troops from 20 Armoured Brigade on 6th May, on exercise on Salisbury Plain preparing to deploy to OP HERRICK later this month.

20 Armoured Brigade will come under the command of Regional Command (South West) and it will be the final UK formation to deploy to Afghanistan as combat operations draw to a close by the end of 2014.



The Brigade's Headquarters, currently based in Sennelager in Germany, is due to move to Bulford in 2017.

Waste & Recycling in Camp

In this country generally, 95% of the rubbish which gets sent to landfill could be recovered or recycled. Obviously, better segregation at source would reduce this horrifyingly high figure and the Government target is zero going to landfill by the year 2020.

Inside the garrisons across the Project Allenby/Connaught (PAC) footprint, waste is classified as 'commercial' and its production and what to do with it is a huge issue.

Across PAC in 2013, a total of 3366 tonnes of waste was produced, of which 68% was general waste destined for landfill and only 32% was recovered or recycled.

Currently, TNB Garrison has been the worst performer in terms of the amount of waste that heads to landfill and the percentage that is recovered or recycled. Huge efforts are being made to improve, not only to comply with the Greening Government targets, but also to reduce the cost of disposing of what could be recycled.

The job of trying to improve is made more difficult by :

- **Illegal fly tipped household rubbish** from both inside and outside the wire entering the Garrison commercial waste stream. The Garrison and the civilian Police are actively tackling this problem and where individual perpetrators can be identified, action will be taken. Domestic waste can be taken to any of the 11 household recycling centres in Wiltshire - details can be found at www.recycleforwiltshire.com

- **Rubbish put in the wrong bin** contaminates the remainder of the correctly disposed-of rubbish in that bin.

The Garrison, in partnership with ADSL and our waste contractor, Hills Waste Solutions Ltd, recently piloted a Waste Awareness presentation to Garrison HQ staff.

This initiative is now being rolled out across the Garrison and Units wanting further information should contact the TNB Garrison SHEF team.
