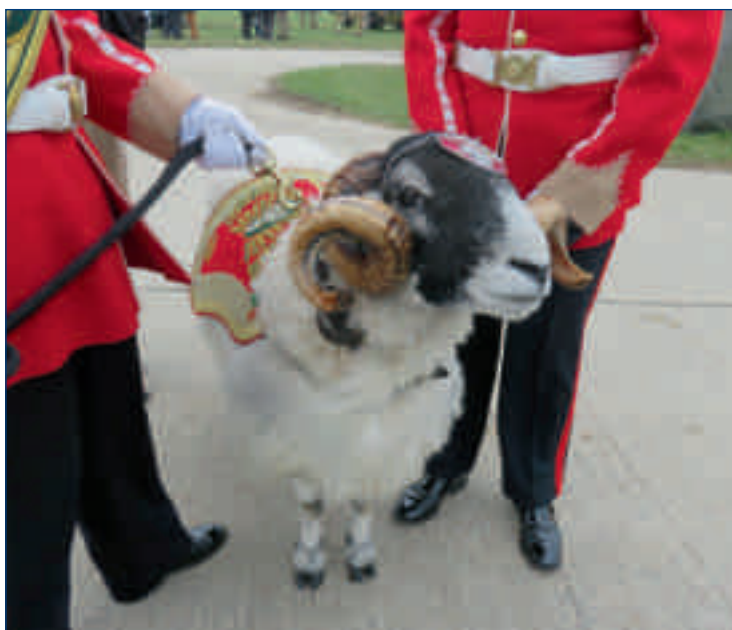

Prime Minister visits Bulford

The Prime Minister, the Rt Hon Theresa May MP, visited 1st Battalion the Mercian Regiment in Picton Barracks on 29th September, to meet the soldiers and families of the unit that is part of the Army's high readiness Task Force.

The 1st Battalion The Mercian Regiment (1MERCIAN), joined by members of 32 Regiment Royal Artillery, 1 Regiment Royal Horse Artillery, 22 Regiment Royal Engineers and the Royal Tank Regiment, were conducting a readiness inspection under Commanding Officer, Lt Col Paddy Ginn, when the Prime Minister dropped in to join him and meet the soldiers and families of the Regiment.



The Prime Minister met members of the Battalion's B Company along with members of Ajax Squadron, The Royal Tank Regiment who supported the inspection with their Challenger 2 main battle tanks that would support 1MERCIAN in the event of any deployment.

The readiness inspection, led by the Commanding Officer, is designed to ensure that all members of the unit are

fully prepared to deploy within their high readiness timelines and involves the



inspection of personal kit and equipment, training standards, vehicles and documents. All of this ensures that the unit is ready to deploy anywhere in the world to achieve the desired effect.



After meeting the troops, the Prime Minister moved to the Warrant Officers' and Sergeants' Mess to meet the families of the Officers and Soldiers of the battalion in an informal setting to discuss service life for the families.

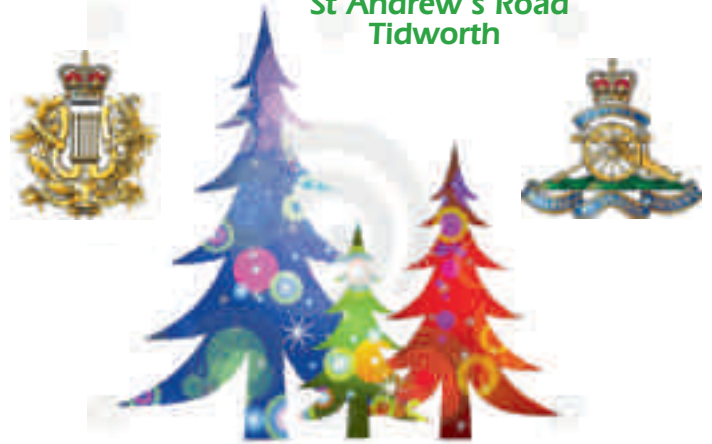
SSgt Amy Baker, who works in the Headquarters 3rd (United Kingdom) Division and is married to Sgt Jon Baker of 1MERCIAN, met the Prime Minister during the visit. "It was a fantastic opportunity to speak with the Prime Minister in an open and honest environment," she said. "She genuinely took an interest in what we were talking about".

1MERCIAN is part of 1 Armoured Infantry Brigade which is currently the British Army's high readiness formation with elements held from 2 days notice to move in support of any operation unilaterally or with allies including NATO partners. As armoured infantry, the soldiers of the battalion are trained in mounted and dismounted combat operating out of Warrior Infantry Fighting vehicles alongside the Challenger 2 tanks, AS90 artillery and armoured engineers to form the Lead Armoured Battle Group of the high readiness Armoured Infantry Brigade.

The British Army's Combined Arms Manoeuvre Demonstration 2016



This Exercise took place on Salisbury Plain near Larkhill last month, to display the capabilities of a Lead Armoured Battlegroup, with Command, Intelligence, Surveillance and Battlegroup vehicles all working together to deliver a joint effect.

Led by Bulford-based 1 MERCIAN, the demonstration included live firing of a range of weapons, including the Challenger 2 main battle tank and the Javelin anti-tank missile, with air support given by the Apache attack helicopter and the RAF's Tornado attack aircraft.



The Military Covenant in Action



The organisations involved in the 'Our Wilton' project put pen to paper last month, signing up to the Armed Forces Covenant to pledge support for Service veterans.

Watched by representatives from all three Services, including the Reserves, the documents were signed by John Fletcher, Managing Director of Redrow Southern Counties and Matthew BELL, CEO of Our Enterprise/ Our Wilton. The Armed Forces were represented by Col James Coote OBE, Commander of Headquarters SouthWest, who said :

"This is an amazing initiative and one that we really value. The opportunities that this project will provide are unique at this stage and so it is really leading the way in terms of initiatives. It is particularly apt that it should be taking place on the site of the former HQ Land Command, even though veterans from all three Services will benefit. We look forward to working together and making this whole project a success."

The Alabaré Christian Care charity, a partner of 'Our Wilton' for the delivery of the project, had already pledged its support for the covenant and was represented by its CEO, Andrew Lord.

Readers of the September edition of Drumbeat will have read that the 'Our Wilton' project will establish Wiltshire's first purpose-built, community-based campus for vulnerable Service veterans, providing them with housing and support to move back into civilian life. The project also includes an enterprise hub which will offer training and help veterans to launch their own businesses. Veterans will be able to rent homes on the site for a period of 6-24 months while they receive business and skills training. They then move on to make room for another veteran.

A contractor will be chosen in the coming months and building work is expected to begin in the Spring.
