1 (Mech) Brigade Units train for Iraq ...

1 (Mech) Brigade Units will deploy to Iraq in April. They will be part of the Multi-National Division (SE), taking over responsibility for the area of South-Eastern Iraq at present controlled by 20 (Armoured) Brigade. Troops will be based at Basra and will include 1RHA, 22 Engineer Regt, 215 Sig Sqn, 1PWRR, 1CHESHIRE and 6Bn REME. All soldiers have undertaken theatre-specific pre-deployment training and are seen here on exercise on Salisbury Plain.

Use the correct Postal Address!

When using a BFPO address, geographical locations are not needed and SHOULD NOT be included as they could lead to items circulating via civilian postal channels, causing delay and/or excess postal charges.

Blueys

Postage on the Forces' blue aerogramme letter forms to Op Telic addresses is FREE. Write "OP TELIC" in the top left corner of the front cover and remember that enclosures (eg photos) are not permitted.

Parcels

From 8th April, the **free** postal packet service to the Gulf will cease. From this date, the same rate of postage as for other overseas Theatres of Operations will apply.

E-Blueys

E-blueys are printed, folded and sealed without anyone but the sender and the receiver viewing the contents. They are delivered First Class in the UK, or through the BFPO system overseas.

Thinking of Childminding as a Career?

Childminding is particularly suitable as a career option for parents with young children who want to combine paid work with looking after their own children. The work is challenging and rewarding and the number and ages of children cared for are, to an extent, up to you.

If you look after children aged under the age of 8 for more than two hours a day, for payment or reward, you must be registered with Ofsted. A variety of references, (including Police checks), are obtained on the Childminder and on anyone else over the age of 16 living at the same address. An Ofsted Child Care Inspector will visit regularly to ensure that your home is safe and suitable for young children.
