A Royal Visit to mark St David's Day



Her Majesty The Queen, Colonel-In-Chief of The Royal Welsh, attended a Review to mark St David's Day at Lucknow Barracks on 3rd March.



The two Regimental Goats, Shenkin and Llywelyn, were also on parade, following a Royal Welsh tradition which dates back to the late 1700s.

Following the Parade, The Queen proceeded to the Officers' Mess to view displays demonstrating the capability of the Regiment, where she was also able to meet soldiers and their families before lunch.



Accompanied by the Regimental Colonel, Major General James Swift, Her Majesty inspected the Parade in the State Review Range Rover, and presented leeks to a representative group of The Royal Welsh Regimental Family.

Her Majesty gave an address before the Parade concluded with three cheers and a Royal Salute.

5 RIFLES in Estonia

UK Armed Forces in Estonia have taken part in celebrations to mark the country's Independence Day.

Ahead of the deployment of 800 British troops to lead part of NATO's Enhanced Forward Presence in Estonia, an advance team from 5th Battalion the RIFLES already in the country joined the Estonia Independence Day Parade on 24th February, marching through the capital of Tallinn watched by a crowd of thousands.

Britain played a key role in helping the Estonians to gain their independence in 1918 and the two countries have a long history of working together across Defence, including in Afghanistan. Next year marks 100 years since the earliest co-operation between the Royal Navy and Estonia.



At the NATO Warsaw Summit last year, the UK committed to leading one of four battlegroups in NATO's Enhanced Forward Presence in the Baltic States and Poland. In addition to the 800 UK troops, France and Denmark will also deploy personnel to Estonia. British, Estonian, French and Danish troops have been exercising in Germany recently, to prepare for the deployment. The main body of UK troops are due to arrive in Estonia in April, bringing Warrior Armoured Fighting Vehicles and Challenger II tanks. The UK will also be deploying troops to Poland in support of the US-led battle group there.

Forces Media Academy

Service Leavers and Veterans are being offered the opportunity to take part in a unique media course which is being launched this September by the Forces Media Academy. The Academy is part of SSVC, which is also the parent company of BFBS and Forces TV, which specialises in providing media services to the UK Armed Forces around the globe.

Students on this free, one-year, Higher National Certificate Media Production Course will also receive a bursary of £18,000 to help with living costs, provided by The Royal British Legion.

Forces Media Academy Director, Alistair Halliday, said : "We are delighted to offer this bespoke course to Service leavers and veterans who are interested in pursuing a second career in the media. This will include those who have suffered injuries or sickness while in service."

Work experience and practical skills feature heavily in the course, which starts on 25th September 2017 and will run until July 2018 at SSVC's headquarters in Buckinghamshire, so students will have the opportunity to work with award-winning media teams alongside the programme of lectures.

Military Communities to benefit

New Tank Crossing on the Bulford Droveaway

The new bridge over the 9-mile river in Bulford was lifted into place at the beginning of last month.

The bridge is part of a new military road which will enable military vehicles to drive out of the back gate of Ward/Wing Barracks, across the Droveaway and directly onto the Training Area, thereby reducing traffic congestion in Bulford village.



This new road is just one of the 47 major construction projects being run nationwide by the Army Basing Programme, which is responsible for ensuring that facilities are in place for troops returning to the UK from Germany. In this area, as well as producing living accommodation for single soldiers and working areas inside the camps, they will also be providing accommodation for families in Larkhill, Bulford, Tidworth and Perham Down.

This construction work, which will be taking place inside and outside the wire, and the extra troops who will be coming to live and work here within the next few years will, of course, all add to the traffic in this area. Consequently, the Army Basing Programme is also looking at road junctions, in conjunction with Wiltshire Council, to see how traffic flows can be improved.

There are certain administrative requirements which must be met :

- Your dog must be registered with your QM;
- Your dog must be insured, including public liability insurance;
- Your dog must be micro-chipped (a legal requirement);
- Your dog's immunisation boosters must be up-to-date;
- Your dog must be UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.

*** In response to a recent incident, BE AWARE :**
Military Working Dogs patrol the inside perimeter of the camp. If your dog attacks, the military working dog will be released and allowed to defend itself.
