Army v Navy Rugby

The Royal Tank Regiment sets a new Challenge ...

How many men does it take to pull a tank ?

Last month, soldiers from the Royal Tank Regiment decided to find out !

One hundred years after the tank first made its appearance on the battle fields of the Western Front in the battle of Flers-Courcelette during the Somme Offensive, soldiers from The Royal Tank Regiment lined up in the Aliwal Tank Park to pull the British Army's 62,500kg Challenger 2 Main Battle Tank into the record book.



A Scimitar Armoured Reconnaissance Vehicle (8070kg) provided a gentle warm-up pull over the 100-metre course, before the star attraction was rolled into position.

Ropes attached, 80 soldiers took the strain and, once inertia was overcome, they made the task look really easy, with the Challenger moving smoothly over the finishing line in just over 2 minutes.

"That was really hard work!" said Lt Col Nick Cowey, the Commanding Officer. "We're hoping that this will get into the Guinness Book of Records - and we hope we've put a marker down and a challenge out there for the rest of the Tank community in the British Army to come and try to beat our time!"

NB. KRH and QRH : the time to beat is 2.09 minutes !

The Regiment is now waiting to hear whether the Guinness World Record Committee has verified their attempt.

The Royal Tank Regiment will soon be celebrating the centenary of its foundation as well as one of its main Battle Honours, the Battle of Cambrai. The centenary will be marked by events held at the Tank Museum in Bovington.

Exercise Enduro Spanner

Last month, soldiers from the 1st Regiment Royal Horse Artillery Workshop, based in Tidworth's Assaye Barracks, began a fundraising event to raise money for the ABF The Soldiers' Charity, taking place at Tesco Extra in Andover and called Exercise Enduro Spanner.

Enduro Spanner consisted of completing the equivalent distance of rowing the channel, cycling the route from Folkestone, via John O'Groats and Lands End, to London, where they would then run the London marathon. All of this was to be completed by the 6-man team on gym equipment in a continuous 24 hour rotation over 6 days!

The team got off to a good start and the channel row was completed within a respectable 5 hours. The generosity of the public also started to become evident as the donation buckets started to become heavy. With the row complete, the team began the cycle. They had a huge distance to cover and at a pace that would see them finish in time for the marathon, 6 days later.



With overnight temperatures dropping below zero and tiredness starting to kick in, the team maintained their pace and reached their fundraising target of £5000 by lunchtime on day 3!

The team entered the final day of the cycle with less than 600km to go until reaching London for the marathon. Generous customers were filling up the donation buckets fast and were stopping to talk to us about the charity.

Tesco Andover Extra store manager, Andy McColl, started off the marathon at 9am on day 6, with BFBS's Chris Pearson taking his turn later on in the morning. The team completed the marathon in 3hrs 20mins which is an outstanding feat, especially for 6 guys that had been cycling for the last 5 days!

The final total was counted and a cheque was presented to ABF The Soldiers' Charity for the sum of £12,401.12 which is an amazing effort from everyone. The total distance covered was 3160km which works out at 526km per team member. We would like to give a big thank you to Tesco Andover Extra, to BFBS for all the publicity and to the public for generously supporting our worthy cause.



Bulford Road Closure

The Bulford Droveaway will be closed during Exercise TRACTABLE 16, a military exercise which will be taking place on the training area this month.

- 27 Dorset Close in Bulford (3 bedroom houses)
- 24 Pembroke Rd in Upavon (3 bedroom houses)
- 20 Graham Square in Larkhill (2 bedroom, ground floor flat).

These houses are available throughout the year to Service personnel, with priority given to single parents for contact with children. Nightly charges are £25 (house)/£20 (flat) with a minimum weekend charge of £75/ £60 regardless of the number of nights used.

Bookings can be made through the AWS on Tidworth Mil (94342) Ext 5789 or Civil 01980 656789 up to three months in advance, for up to a maximum stay of two weeks.

A Helping Hand for the Hub

In late September last year, the manager of The District Specialist Centre at Tidworth's Ashdown Centre informed Caterpillars Under 5's, one of the TNB Early Years settings, that after October 2015 they would not be able to maintain the specialist childcare services at their 'Hub' in Tidworth.

The manager at Caterpillars approached the TNB Early Years Executive Coordinator with a plan to offer her Deputy, Melanie Robinson, to cover the period from October to December 2015, to ensure services were not disrupted for the children in the area.

Despite this help, due to managerial and financial circumstances, the Centre had to close at the end of the term in December 2015.

TNB EYP is working closely with the new manager at The District Specialist Centre in Devizes and the local community, to help bring this valued and much needed service back into Tidworth.

The annual Community Awards event, organised by the Tidworth Community Area Partnership, is all about giving public recognition to those who volunteer their own time to help

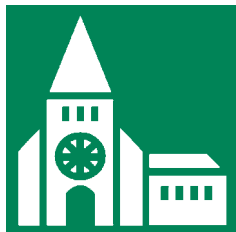

Coronation Street Actor visits Troops on Salisbury Plain

Actor Antony Cotton, who plays the part of Sean Tully in the TV soap, Coronation Street, has made a whistle stop visit to Salisbury Plain, meeting troops from Bulford's 1 Mercian Regiment and 158 Provost Company RMP, as well as Tidworth's Royal Regiment of Fusiliers.

As an Ambassador for Help 4 Heroes, he also dropped in to visit Tidworth House, meeting some of our sick, wounded and injured personnel.

Antony's relationship with the Army began several years ago when he supported soldier friends as they prepared and deployed to Afghanistan. Since then his network of friends within the Army has grown and several of them have visited the set of the world's longest running soap.



While with the First Fusiliers, he learned about the regimental history of the Regiment of Fusiliers, a regiment whose recruiting ground includes his home town of Bury in Lancashire. He chatted to soldiers and learned more about their roles, training, equipment and preparation for operational theatre. After dropping into the Gym to meet the boxing team, he then went to the workshops where he was shown around a Warrior Infantry Fighting Vehicle, a tool of the trade for the Fusiliers.

Antony also visited 158 Provost Company (Royal Military Police) based in Bulford, where he was given a demonstration of Personal Safety Training (PST) in which personnel used their acting skills in 'role play' to demonstrate techniques used to keep themselves and the public safe when dealing with a suspect.



Antony said: "I have several friends in the Army and it's a world that I have been involved in for several years and that involvement has grown and grown.

"I support the lads and lasses that go out to protect and defend us and I am grateful to them, but on a personal level, I am proud of my friends and proud of what they do and I am honoured to be part of it."

Speaking to the soldiers, he said he placed a high importance on continued and varied training as history has shown that UK deployments have in the past been rapid and often to unexpected locations and situations.

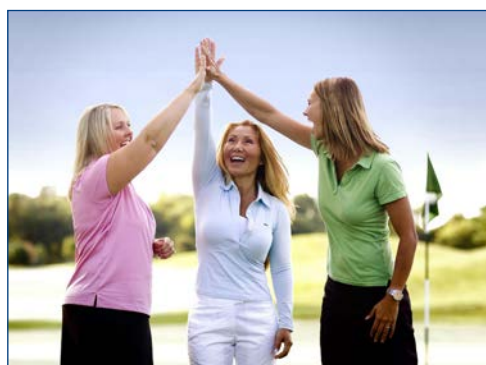
